MAMMOGRAMS SAVE LIVES YET HISPANIC WOMEN FAIL TO HAVE REGULAR SCREENINGS

"Only 38% of Hispanic women age 40 and older have regular screening mammograms. It is extremely important that women make their health a priority². "
